#3 ... Visit any Azzip Pizza location! Azzip is very generous with "kids eat free" coupons. Pick up coupons at library summer reading programs or at most banks or credit unions during the Fall season.

#2 ... Pack up the scooters, the skateboards, the bicycles, and the kids, and head to the Pigeon Creek Greenway Passage. This trail is widely accessible throughout Evansville: Parking is available at Sunset Park (Shawnee Drive near downtown along the river), at the end of 7th Avenue just south of Lloyd Expressway/State Road 62, Lamasco Park (Iowa Street near the river), nearby Garvin Park (off Main Street), and at the end of Heidelberg Avenue.
